






Guide to Meter Reading – why is it so important?

Why do we need meter readings and why do we need to ensure that our supplier's meters are working correctly and any problems with them are resolved quickly?

<p>The University spends approximately <u>£2 million</u> a year on energy bills. <p>It's the Law. <p>Identify problems</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Energy being used when it should not be • Faulty equipment • Leaks • Unauthorised use /theft 	
<p>To identify high areas of high energy use:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • so that we can concentrate our resources on energy saving projects 	
<p>In the interests of efficiency and speed of data capture we are working towards automating the meter reading process for all meters on campus.</p>
