





Unauthorised Portable Heaters

<p>Unauthorised portable heaters can also increase risks to University:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • buildings • services • equipment • structures • and increase health and safety hazards 	
<p>How can I Help?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not use unauthorised portable heaters (or any other unauthorised equipment) on the University campus • Wear clothing that is appropriate to the weather
