Do you want to study at the University of Huddersfield but worry that you might not pass our English language entrance requirements?

We have the answer. Our Pre-Sessional Programmes (PSP) are designed to give you the English skills you need to succeed in your studies and enjoy life at our University.

Our courses run from four weeks to six months depending on current English ability. Courses run throughout the year, whether you are starting your degree in January or September, without re-taking IELTS.

Whilst studying, you will have access to all our University's facilities including the library, sports centre and computers. You will not be alone, studying alongside students from different nationalities, building your confidence in English together and getting used to your new home in Huddersfield.

You will also receive immigration support from our friendly and knowledgeable team.

Our teachers are highly experienced and passionate about teaching English and you'll quickly see big improvements in your English language grammar, vocabulary and the four key skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing.

With tutor support you will be encouraged to learn individually and in small groups to develop your knowledge and skills. In addition to general English, topics related to University courses are also introduced.

During your studies with the University, you will then receive on-going academic support which will help you with your studies throughout the course of your degree programme.

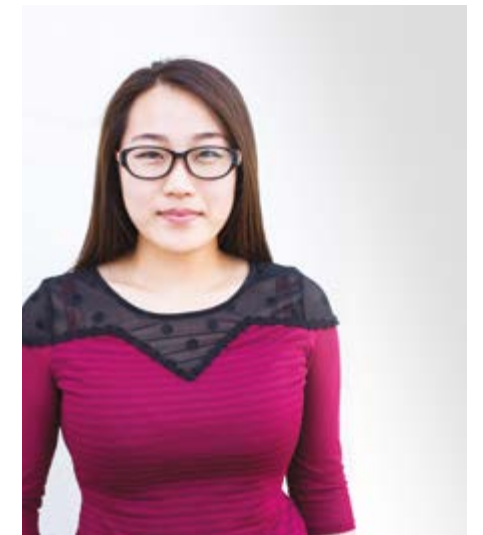
