Opening October 2014

Heritage Quay includes a world-class experiential space for interaction with the archival collections and flexible space for a wide range of events, exhibitions and learning activities based on the archives. Facilities for individual researchers are available, alongside state-of-the-art environmentally-controlled secure storage to ensure the continued preservation of fragile and vulnerable archives. These facilities are among the first in the UK to be built to this standard.

The Heritage Lottery Fund and University of Huddersfield are funding a major archives project 2012-2017 costing £2million+; stage 1 is completed and we are now 6 months into stage 2. The most visible and expensive part of the project are the capital works in the old “Café on 3rd” to create the Heritage Quay, opening in autumn 2014.
