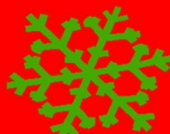

COUP Lifetime Achievement Recognition Award 2019

The National Procurement Conference Lifetime Achievement Recognition Award 2019 goes to Mr John Thompson – University of Huddersfield

"This category recognises the outstanding contribution to procurement in the Higher Education sector, by an individual, over an extended period of over 20 years. Those who have made an exceptional difference to our community rightly deserve to be thanked. John joined the University of Huddersfield in 1993, and has worked

tirelessly to continuously improve the University's procurement performance. This was evidenced through external validation, the University achieving "superior status" in the PMA assessment, the first northern university to do so. John has raised the profile of procurement both within the University and throughout the sector and has in the past reached the finalists for the Government procurement awards and THELMAs for Outstanding Procurement Team. Regionally, he has chaired numerous commodity groups. Starting in 1995, John became chair of the Stationery and Office Supplies Group, then the Furniture Group and brought about the first successful collaborative regional furniture contract. John represented the sector in the first pan-public framework on reprographics working with The Buying Agency, now Crown Commercial Services, to bring a deal across the whole public procurement sector. He has also Chaired the Northern Universities Insurance Group (2013-2015) and organised the National Insurance conferences and has been procurement adviser to the North Eastern Universities Library Periodicals group for the last five years. He was an original member of the NEUPC board of Directors and the driving force in saving the North Eastern University consortium in 1999, formerly NEUPG, when it seemed it may fold. We would like to thank John for his exceptional contributions to the HE sector."
